**BASS LAKE'S PINES RESORT ANNOUNCES NEW NAME, NEW LOOK
AND NEW ATTITUDE FOR 2009 "ROCK THE DOCK" CONCERTS**
Popular summer concert series offers live bands and BBQ dinner each Friday

BASS LAKE, Calif., May 29, 2009 – When The Pines Resort kicks off its popular summer lakeside concert series on June 12, guests will notice some exciting changes – including a new event name. Formerly known as the “Jazz on the Lake” series, the live concerts are now called “Rock the Dock,” which more accurately describes the high energy stage shows.

The Pines Resort’s summer concert series has evolved through the years to become well known as Central California’s premiere outdoor venue for contemporary rock and party bands. According to Ava Hinojosa, Pines Resort’s Director of Marketing, “The new ‘Rock the Dock’ name better captures the casual, fun and outdoorsy spirit of the concerts – where once the music starts, the dancing begins!”

The 13-week series features a revolving calendar of established musicians on the resort’s Lakeside Stage, which is set up for cocktails, dining and enjoying panoramic views of the sun setting over scenic Bass Lake. Each Friday (with exception of the special Saturday July 4 concert), the gates open at 6 p.m. with an expansive BBQ buffet and live music beginning at 6:30 p.m. The bands play a full three-hour set and a dazzling fireworks display follows concerts scheduled in July and August.

The special Rock the Dock menu is a classic outdoor BBQ picnic theme, designed to appeal to all ages and tastes. Selections change weekly but range from the locally famous Pines Resort barbeque ribs and chicken to hot dogs, hamburgers, corn-on-the-cob, baked beans, assorted salads, cornbread and the resort’s signature Strawberry Shortcake.

Concert goers have their choice of two package options which both include the BBQ buffet dinner. Premium Concert Deck dinner packages, with stage front seating, can be reserved at \$25 per person and Concert Lawn dinner packages, with seating adjacent to the stage area, are available at \$16 per person. Children’s pricing for either dinner package, is \$12 each (ages 5 to 12). A full bar is available; cocktails, tax and gratuity are not included in package prices.
