TRANSPORTATION AND DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO BASS LAKE AND THE PINES RESORT

The Pines Resort and Conference Center is located at beautiful Bass Lake, on Sierra National Forest land in California's Eastern Madera County. The resort's physical address (for online directions) is 54432 Road 432, Bass Lake, CA 93604.

Driving Directions

From Sacramento -- Take Hwy. 99 South to Merced. In Merced, take Hwy. 140 East to Mariposa. In Mariposa, take a wide right turn onto Hwy. 49 Southeast to Oakhurst. In Oakhurst, take Hwy. 41 North toward Yosemite just 3.5 miles to the Bass Lake turnoff (Road 222). Follow this road and Pines Resort signage directing you 6 additional miles into The Pines Village. (Approximate driving time: 3 ½ hours)

From Los Angeles -- Take Hwy. 5 North to Bakersfield. In Bakersfield, take Hwy. 99 North to Fresno. In Fresno, take Hwy. 41 North (toward Yosemite). Just 3.5 miles past the town of Oakhurst, turn right at the Bass Lake turnoff (Road 222). Follow this road and Pines Resort signage directing you 6 additional miles into The Pines Village. (Approximate driving time: 5 hours).

From the Bay Area -- Take Hwy. 580 East to the 5 South to the 132 East to Modesto. In Modesto, take 99 South to Merced. From Merced, take 140 East to Mariposa. From Mariposa take 49 South (wide right turn from Hwy 140) to signal at Hwy. 41 in Oakhurst. Turn left onto Hwy. 41 (toward Yosemite) and follow the highway just 3.5 miles to the Bass Lake turnoff. (Road 222). Follow this road and Pines Resort signage directing you 6 additional miles into The Pines Village. (Approximate driving time: 4 hours).

From Fresno/Yosemite Int'l Airport -- From airport exit turn left onto Clinton Way to first signal. Turn right onto McKinley and drive approximately 3 miles to Hwy. 41 North entrance. Stay on Hwy. 41 (toward Yosemite) and pass through the town of Oakhurst. Just 3.5 miles past Oakhurst, turn right on the Bass Lake turnoff (Highway 222). Follow this road and Pines Resort signage directing you 6 additional miles into The Pines Village. (Approximate driving time: 1 ½ hours).
